The time has come to fill boxes for Hays County Food Bank's annual Turkeys Tackling Hunger Holiday Meal Box Program, and Night Hawk Frozen Foods, Inc. is ready for the task. For the 4th consecutive year, Night Hawk Frozen Foods, Inc. is halting production on their famous frozen dinners to instead stuff boxes with traditional holiday foods like green beans, stuffing, and pumpkin.¹



On Friday, November 9th, at 8:00 AM, Night Hawk employees will begin assembly of a little over 2,000 holiday meal boxes. Owners, Scott and Leanne Logan, have been supporting the food bank efforts since 2014, and enjoy taking a hands on approach to helping tackle hunger in Hays County. They've even jumped behind the assembly line to help with production. This is their 5th year as Title Sponsor for Turkeys Tackling Hunger.

The week prior to Thanksgiving, the filled holiday meal boxes will make their journey, with the help of Little Guys Movers, to distribution sites throughout the county. Food bank staff and volunteers will be awaiting these parcels to then hand out to families who have signed up to receive this special gift.
